Enchiladas or Enchilada Casserole

Needed: Corn tortillas (or corn chips), Velveeta-like cheese or other vegan cheese, enchilada sauce, and filling

Filling: 1 cup chopped onion 2 cups burger delight¹ 2 cups refried beans
Enchilada sauce Velveeta-like Cheese² Olive oil

Sauté onion and burger. Add other ingredients.

Enchilada Sauce: 1 can tomato paste OR 4 Tbsp tomato powder + ½ cup extra water
2 Tbsp olive oil 3 cups water 2 tsp salt
2 tsp lemon juice ½ tsp cumin 5 garlic
cloves, pressed (2 ½ Tbsp powder)
½ tsp paprika or more 1 tsp Pero, to color 4 Tbsp cornstarch OR 1/3 cup flour

Cook in saucepan on the stovetop until thickened

The Finishing Touch: Fill each tortilla with large spoonfuls of filling. Roll up and arrange them in a casserole dish. Cover with remaining sauce and spread the top with Velveeta-like cheese. It spreads quite well if it is newly made and hot. (You may also decide to layer these ingredients more like lasagna for a casserole—it tastes the same and is quicker. You may also replace tortillas with corn chips for the casserole, if desired.) Bake at 350°F (175°C) for 30 minutes.

The Three Angels and their Counterfeits

Editor's Note, Study to Show Thyself Approved, and Prophetic News Notes



A Chinese boy who wanted to learn about jade went to study with a talented old teacher. This gentleman put a piece of the precious stone into his hand and told him to hold it tight. Then he began to talk of philosophy, men, women, the sun and almost everything under it. After an hour he took back the stone and sent the boy home. The procedure was repeated for several weeks. The boy became frustrated. When would he be told about the jade? He was too polite, however, to question the wisdom of his venerable teacher. Then one day, when the old man put a stone into his hands, the boy cried out instinctively, "That's not jade!"

Indeed, the best way to recognize a counterfeit is to be familiar with the true! For many years, God's people have uplifted the 3 Angels' Messages. Yet, sadly, after many generations, many of those who endorse them cannot even tell you where to find them in the Bible or what they are about. Because they are not familiar with the true, when a counterfeit message comes, they will not recognize it as spurious. In Revelation 16,

the Bible briefly exposes the nature of a counterfeit threefold message, "*And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty." Revelation 16:13, 14 This counterfeit is seen in the whole world. In like manner, the God's first angel of Revelation 14:6 also has a message for "*them that dwell on the earth...*" It goes "*to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people...*" The true three angels' messages are to prepare people for the soon return of Christ, while the counterfeit will prepare people for Satan's deceptions and the mark of the beast. God's message appears to be for the common man (people), while the devil's seems to be primarily to convince the leadership of the world (kings) by signs and wonders to fight against God. However, we know from Revelation 13: 7, 12, 15 that the leadership will use force to compel the common people.*

The message of the first angel is summarized as "*And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people...*"

Revelation 14:6 By looking at the opposites piece by piece, note how many counterfeits there are for this part of the first angel just on the surface.

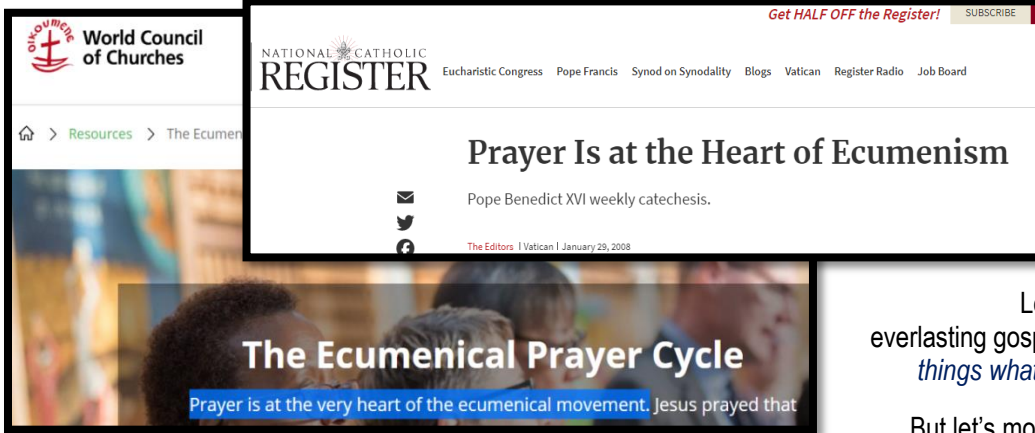
- 1-- a message that is not the everlasting gospel (a spurious gospel)
- 2- an everlasting gospel that is not preached (pew warmers, not missionaries)
- 3 - an everlasting gospel that is not a worldwide movement.

Let's expound a little on counterfeit #1 - a spurious message that is not the everlasting gospel. The word gospel means good news. And, we find at Jesus' birth an angel from heaven proclaimed, "*behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:10, 11 To be a true "everlasting gospel" it must include Jesus whose name literally means Jehovah saves. (Matt. 1:21) That's good news! And Jesus is from everlasting for He said, "*Before Abraham was, I am." John 8:58 In Galatians, Paul warned to stay away from another gospel being preached even by a counterfeit angel. "*I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed." Gal. 1:6-9 The true gospel will match that of the Bible writers. I like this summary of the everlasting gospel. "*The gospel of Christ is the Good News of grace, or favor, by which man may be released from the condemnation of sin and enabled to render obedience to the law of God.*"***



Now let's look a little deeper at counterfeit #2 - an everlasting gospel that is not preached. In the description of the first angel, the word preach is "euaggelizō" meaning "to announce good news" or evangelize as we would say in English. Also, in Mark 16:15 and Matthew 28:19, 20, the Great Commission from Jesus was given with a directive to "preach" and "teach" the gospel. "*And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.*" Mark 16:15 "*Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen." Matt. 28:19, 20 But today, many churches have agreed not to evangelize other religions, instead they come together in a false unity with watered down services that only include what they can all agree on. As I have mentioned before, other things, like ecumenical prayer or humanitarian work are emphasized to keep people busy "doing good" and thinking they are missionaries while they are not actually spreading the truths of the gospel. While there is nothing*

wrong with kindness or praying the biblical, old-fashioned way, be warned that both the World Council of Churches and the National Catholic Register, quoting Vatican II, state that *“Prayer is at the very heart of the ecumenical movement.”* or *“ecumenism.”*² We should be very leery of any church where the word of God and doctrine are being deemphasized or watered down. Because we are



warned with *“How is the faithful city become an harlot!”* whose *“silver is become dross”* and whose *“wine [is] mixed with water:”* Isaiah 1:21, 22 (Silver= God’s word, Psalm 12:6; wine= doctrine, Isaiah 28:7, new wine or grape juice is pure doctrine, alcoholic wine is false doctrine)

Let us not forget that preaching the everlasting gospel includes *“teaching... to observe all things whatsoever... [Jesus] commanded...”*

But let’s move on to the rest of the 1st angel’s message. It picks up in Revelation 14:7 *“Saying with*

a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.” Counterfeits for this portion of the 1st angel would include a muffled or secret message as opposed to a loud one. Also any message not teaching the fear of God (which should cause us to respect Him enough to keep His commandments-Deut. 8:6) or teaching the *“fear of man [which] bringeth a snare..”* Prov. 29:25, any message that glorifies man, nature, inventions, etc., instead of God, any message undermining the fact that we are living in the judgment hour or teaching that there is no judgment, any message that does not worship the Creator in the way He has specified.

Now the scope of this article does not allow me to delve deeply into each of these counterfeits, but I want to talk the last one and demonstrate that there are different levels to each of these. Remember the angel says, *“Worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.”* Now, in Revelation 16:13, 14 we learned that the counterfeit comes from three unclean spirits, one out of the mouth of the dragon, one out of the mouth of the beast, and one out of the mouth of the false prophet. The dragon will be the most blatant paganism, the beast representing a universal form of “baptized paganism,” and the false prophet a more tame- appearing beast that speaks like a dragon (Rev. 13:11) deceiving people into making “an image to the beast”(Rev. 13:14).

The dragon’s counterfeit for worship of the Creator is the exact opposite-- not worshipping the Creator. This we see in the evolutionary theory taught today. Peter wrote under inspiration, *“There shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts...For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth...”* 2 Peter 3:3,5 Interestingly, the first and second messages were given in 1843 & 1844 in connection with the Second Advent Movement. Not by accident, the dragon’s counterfeit evolutionary theory also surfaced about this time. Charles *“Darwin’s first two, relatively complete, explicit articulations of his theorizing on evolution were his Essay of 1844 and On the Origin of Species published in 1859.”*³

But let’s move on to see the beast’s counterfeit for worshipping the Creator. Looking in the Bible for similar texts to Revelation 14: we find in Exodus 20:8-11 **how** we are to worship *“the LORD [who] made heaven and earth, the sea...”* Exodus 20:11 This section of scripture gives a simple yet definite description of how the Creator wants us to remember to worship Him. It says, *“Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it”.* Exodus 20:8-11 As you might imagine the “beast” power turns the signpost around. Since God says worship Him, the Son, the seventh or last day of the week, the beast says to worship on the day of the sun, the first day of the week. The following quotation from Priest Thomas Enright, in 1884, shows who claims to have done this. *“Prove to me from the Bible alone that I am bound to keep Sunday holy. There is no such law in the Bible. It is a law of the holy Catholic Church alone. The Bible says ‘Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy.’ The Catholic Church says, No, By my divine power I abolish the Sabbath day and command you to keep holy the first day of the week. And lo! The entire civilized world bows down in reverent obedience to the command of the Holy Catholic Church.”*⁴ (More information on this topic may be found in our Bible Study Lessons [“A Command to Remember”](#)⁵ and [“The Mark of the Beast”](#)⁶)



The false prophet counterfeit for worship of the Creator, will be a mixture of the previous two since it is spoken like a dragon, but also contains the image of the beast. (Rev. 13:11,14) It will not match God’s word, but be like that described in Jeremiah 14:14.

“Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the deceit of their heart.” Now for the dragon voice of the false prophet, if one does not worship the Creator, he will ultimately worship the creature. This is nature worship that Paul spoke about in Romans. “Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.” Romans 1:25 Today, this is often falsely characterized as “science,” and evolutionary theory when it is actually “oppositions of science falsely so called.” 1 Timothy 6:20 Also, from recent news, we note how nature worship may be connected with climate action plans. In June 2024, Pope Francis released an official document called Fratello Sole, or “Brother Sun”, which outlines the Vatican plans to transition to 100% solar energy for the Vatican City State. The document is a reference to Francis of Assisi, who is considered the patron saint of ecology and wrote the Canticle of Brother Sun and Sister Moon in the 13th century.⁷ Although there is nothing wrong with installing solar panels, note, just the name of this document is actually nature worship,



not to mention, blasphemous since only Jesus, the Son, S-O-N is our Brother. But in the future, we may expect various religious leaders to turn their back on God's temple of time (the Sabbath) and His temple of truth (His Pure Word). They will worship nature, especially the sun, instead. Ezekiel 8:16 predicted, “And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD'S house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about five and twenty men, with **their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east.**”

We may expect the counterfeit messengers to endorse doing the opposite of the 1st angel, the opposite of the 2nd angel, and the opposite of the 3rd angel. The 2nd angel includes, Babylon is fallen, so we might expect a denial of Babylon's fall. The 3rd angel would include the description of the saints described in Revelation 14:12 that reads, “Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.” But the counterfeit three angels will be teaching people to break God's commandments and to be faithless or presumptuous (claiming God's promises without fulfilling the conditions of His commands—Deut. 1:43). In contrast, by God's grace, I pray that we will all be found faithfully worshipping the Creator, keeping God's commandments and having the faith of Jesus.

Eliminating Seven Causes of Forgetfulness

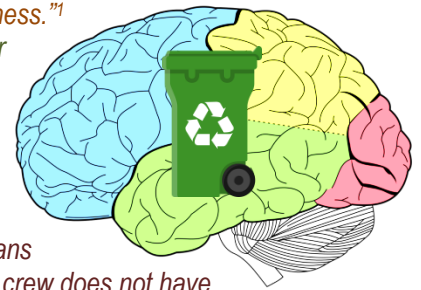
A large portion of the people I've talked to or heard about recently are having problems with forgetfulness. Since a healthy body and a healthy mind go hand in hand. Let's us look at a few causes of forgetfulness and how to improve your chances of remembering.

Lack of sleep-- “Not getting enough sleep is perhaps the greatest unappreciated cause of forgetfulness.”¹

One reason is that “Lack of sleep affects a part of the brain called the hippocampus, which is key for making new memories. You accumulate many memories, moment by moment, while you're awake.

Most will be forgotten during the day. ‘When we first form memories, they're in a very raw and fragile form’ says sleep expert Dr. Robert Stickgold of Harvard Medical School. But when you doze off, ‘sleep seems to be a privileged time when the brain goes back through recent memories and decides both what to keep and what not to keep,’ Stickgold explains. ‘During a night of sleep, some memories are strengthened.’² Also, “Scientist have found that while you sleep your brain cleans

out toxins that build up throughout the day. Without adequate sleep, the brain's waste management crew does not have time enough to do its job and trash piles up, causing brain fog and memory problems. One study found that in older people, a lack of deep sleep causes a 55% drop in memory the next day.”³ Memory Tip: Make sure you are getting at least 7-8 hours of sleep per night.



Too Much Multi-tasking—“In some cases, forgetfulness may have less to do with memory problems and more to do with distractions. A 2020 survey of 2,000 people in the U.S. shows that 6 in 10 Americans experience ‘multi-tasking forgetfulness.’ Juggling too many tasks takes a toll on the brain's memory centers and can have consequences at work, at school and in relationships.”³ Memory tip: If you want to have better recall, cut out unnecessary distractions. Turn off the TV, put down your phone, and finish simple projects so you can move on and concentrate on others.

Alcohol and Medications-- *“Drinking too much alcohol can interfere with short-term memory, even after the effects of alcohol have worn off.”*¹ Also, *“Chronic alcoholism can lead to long-term memory issues.”*⁴ Medications can also cause forgetfulness. *“Tranquilizers, antidepressants, some blood pressure drugs, and other medications can affect memory, usually by causing sedation or confusion.”*¹

Also, *“Many medications—such as sleep aids, cholesterol-lowering drugs, or anti-anxiety pills—can mess with your memory. For example, sleeping pills act on brain pathways involved in the memory-making process”*³ Cholesterol lowering drugs negatively affect the brain because *“cholesterol is critical for healthy brain functioning and decreased levels can interfere with memory.”*³ (Don't worry, the body can make all the cholesterol it needs.) Memory Tip: Eliminate alcohol and medications that cause forgetfulness.

Underactive Thyroid—*“Research shows that more than 80% of people with low-grade hypothyroidism have impaired memory function.”*³ This is because *“Thyroid hormones are important for brain development. Iodine deficiency may cause a lack of these hormones, resulting in problems with memory and learning new things. A 2014 study found that the hippocampus was smaller in people with low levels of thyroid hormones. The hippocampus is the part of the brain that affects memory.”*³ Memory Tip: To maintain healthy iodine levels, eat plenty of seaweeds like nori, or kelp, or dulse.

Lack of Nutrition— *“Good nutrition -- including high-quality proteins and fats -- is important to proper brain function. Deficiencies in vitamin B1 and B12 specifically can affect memory.”*⁷ Memory Tip: Make sure you are eating healthy fats like omega-3 rich flaxseed chia, and walnuts. Coconut oil has also been shown to be beneficial for the memory. Legumes and whole grains provide protein and make a great way to get vitamin B-1. And vitamin B-12 may be found in chlorella.⁹

Dehydration--*“The first symptom of a dehydrated brain is memory loss.”*⁵ Actually, *“Studies show that you only need to be 1% dehydrated to experience a 5% decrease in cognitive function. A 2% decrease in brain hydration can result in short term memory loss and ... trouble with math computations. Prolonged dehydration causes brain cells to shrink in size and mass, a condition common in many elderly who have been dehydrated for years.”*⁶ Memory tip: Without water a plant slowly wilts, but as you feed that plant sufficient water, the leaves turn green and lift back up into life again. Humans are no different. To stay hydrated, drink as many ounces of water daily as your body weight in pounds divided by 2.2 or drink as many 250ml glasses of water as you weight in kilograms divided by 7.



Stress and Anxiety or Depression—*“Anything that makes it harder to concentrate and lock in new information and skills can lead to memory problems. Stress and anxiety...can interfere with attention and block the formation of new memories or the retrieval of old ones. Common signs of depression include a stifling sadness, lack of drive, and lessening of pleasure in things you ordinarily enjoy. Forgetfulness can also be a sign of depression — or a consequence of it.”*¹

Memory Tip: Eliminate unnecessary stresses and take time to relax. Think of three things to be thankful for. Eat well and maintain healthy levels of magnesium, iodine, omega-3s, B-6 (avocado), tryptophan (pumpkin seeds) and folate (legumes). Get plenty of sunshine and exercise daily. Listen to encouraging music and claim the promise, *“Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;”* Psalm 103:2, 3

The Circus Elephant

Many years ago, in England, a circus elephant named Bozo was very popular with the public. Children especially loved to crowd around his cage and throw him peanuts. Then one day, there was a sudden change in the elephant's personality. Several times he tried to kill his keeper and when the children came near his cage he would charge toward them as if wanting to trample them to death. It was obvious he would have to be destroyed. The circus owner, a greedy and crude man, decided to stage a public execution of the animal. In this way, he could sell tickets and try to recoup some of the cost of losing such a valuable property. The day came and the huge circus tent was packed. Bozo, in his cage, was in the center ring. Nearby stood a firing squad with high-powered rifles. The manager, standing near the cage, was about ready to give the signal to fire, when out of the crowd came a short, inconspicuous man in a brown derby hat. "There is no need for this," he told the manager quietly. The manager brushed him aside. "He is a bad elephant. He must die before he kills someone."



"You are wrong," insisted the man. "Give me two minutes in the cage alone with him and I will prove you are wrong." The manager turned and stared in amazement. "You will be killed," he said.



"I don't think so," said the man. "Do I have your permission?"

The manager, being the kind of man he was, was not one to pass up such a dramatic spectacle. Even if the man were killed, the publicity alone would be worth millions. "All right," he said, "but first you will have to sign a release absolving the circus of all responsibility." The small man signed the paper.

As he removed his coat and hat, preparing to enter the cage, the manager told the people what was about to happen. A hush fell over the crowd. The door to the cage was unlocked, the man stepped inside, then the door was locked

behind him. At the sight of this stranger in his cage the elephant threw back his trunk, let out a might roar, then bent his head preparing to charge. The man stood quite still, a faint smile on his face as he began to talk to the animal. The audience was so quiet that those nearest the cage could hear the man talking but couldn't make out the words; he seemed to be speaking some foreign language. Slowly, as the man continued to talk, the elephant raised his head. Then the crowd heard an almost piteous cry from the elephant as his enormous head began to sway gently from side to side. Smiling, the man walked confidently to the animal and began to stroke the long trunk. All aggression seemed suddenly to have been drained from the elephant. Docile as a pup now he wound his trunk around the man's waist and the two walked slowly around the ring. The astounded audience could bear the silence no longer and broke out in cheers and clapping.

After a while the man bade farewell to the elephant and left the cage. "He'll be all right now," he told the manager. "You see, he's an Indian elephant and none of you spoke his language, Hindustani. I would advise you to get someone around here who speaks Hindustani. He was just homesick." And with that the little man put on his coat and hat and left.

In like manner, Jesus understands your situation. He came all the way from heaven to earth and risked His life to speak in a language you could understand. Indeed, "*the Word [Jesus] was made flesh, and dwelt among us...*" John 1:14 Like the man in the story caring for the elephant even when no one else did, "*God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.*" Romans 5:8.
